#### **Strategic Planning Retreat Topics**

The Committee finalized the topics for this year's strategic planning retreat, which will be held November 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> in Winters CA.

- 1. Do we need to re-invent PRISM?
- 2. How should PRIMS address members who don't exhibit the pooling mentality?
- 3. What can PRISM do to improve claims administration for members (and ultimately the cost of claims)?

#### **Program Matters**

- A recommendation was made to the Board of Directors to approve a commutation of the EWC 2022/23 statutory policy with Liberty, in exchange for \$3M in return premium
- Approval was given to modify the cybersecurity health check process to include mandatory inclusion of ancillary IT systems at the members' cost
- An update was provided on the MR OCIP Program and Colusa County was approved for participation
- Alliant informed the Committee that with the upcoming renewal of the Pollution Program, the carrier will be requiring all properties, including vacant land, be scheduled
- City of Corona was considered for participation in the Cyber Liability Program however, additional information was requested for consideration at the next meeting
- Staff reviewed the process for 2024/25 budget estimates which will be distributed to members in the near future
